What is Soroptimist?

A service group comprised of business and professional women who are leaders in their fields and committed to giving back to the community. Membership is by invitation.

Who joins Soroptimist?

Highly motivated and successful individuals in the community. Many are in key decision-making positions. Soroptimist members are accountants, advertising executives, architects, attorneys, bankers, business owners, doctors, engineers, high-level government executives, and community activists, to name a few.

Whom does Soroptimist benefit?

Soroptimist members benefit from the satisfaction of community service, new perspectives and the friendships of like-minded women. Our club's philosophy is *maximum results from minimum efforts*. Service projects have ranged from gala events raising upwards of \$40,000 for a single beneficiary to elbow grease efforts. Beneficiaries include not-for-profit organizations, schools and government agencies within our local community.

What is the history of Soroptimist?

Soroptimists are women of all ages, cultures and ethnic groups whose mission and purpose is to advance human rights and the status of women. The first Soroptimist club was formed in 1921 by a group of 80 women in Oakland, CA. Since then, membership has grown to nearly 100,000 women in 119 countries and territories around the world. Soroptimist Metro, chartered in 1983 with 26 members, is one of 60 Soroptimist clubs in the Sierra Nevada Region.

How do I become a member?

- Attend at least three meetings to make sure this is the organization for you. (Come to your first meeting as our guest! At subsequent meetings you will pay \$15 each time for breakfast costs.)
- Fill out the application and return it to your sponsor.
- Receive approval from the Membership Committee and the Board.
- Participate in the induction ceremony at which time you introduce yourself to the group.
